

HIGH Q GREENHOUSES INFORMATION SHEET

ORNAMENTAL GRASS PURPLE MAJESTY ORNAMENTAL MILLET

A 2003 All-America Selections **Gold Medal** Winner! Great in gardens or planters as a striking backdrop plant.



Flowering Time

- Bronze-purple cattail-like flower plumes long in summer
- Plumes are 30-35 cm/2-14"

Habit

- 1.2 m/48" tall and 90 cm/36" wide
- Young leaves are green, as they mature in direct sunlight they become purple
- Mature leaves are long and slender, with a red midrib

Requirements

- **Light** – Sun – plant in full sun for darkest purple color
- **Soil** – Well drained with pH of 5.5-6.5
- **Water** – Maintain even moisture – do not allow plants to wilt
- **Fertilizer** – Feed weekly with 150-200 ppm N in a complete fertilizer
- **Temperature** – 18-19°C/64-66°F nights, 20-30°C/68-85°F days
- **Growth Rate** – Transplanted into gallon containers, 5-6 weeks green, 11-13 weeks flowering
- **Regulators** – Bonzi
- **Pests & Diseases** – Aphids
- **Pinching** – Do not pinch

Application

- **Grower:** 4-6" pots, one-gallon containers
- Plants will mostly be green when sold, a color picture tag for the consumer is recommended
- **Consumer:** Mixed containers or patio pots
- Massed plantings in gardens and borders, along fences
- Flower plumes can be dried or left as bird feed in the garden
